



## Lake Callide Family Fishing Classic

### Rules and Regulations

- The Queensland Recreational Fishing Rules are to be complied with at all times.
- Boats must comply with Transport Operations (Maritime Safety) Regulation 2016.
- All winners of categories will be determined by longest lengths.
- Only legal sized fish are eligible for weigh in.
- All fish must be caught in Lake Callide to be entered into the competition.
- A Stocked Impoundment Permit (SIP) is required.
- Fishing is restricted to the dam proper only. NO fishing is allowed in the restricted area as defined by the buoys 200 meters from the dam wall.
- Competitors must produce their wrist band for weighing in fish, collection of any prizes and for the nomination draws.
- Fish species that are included in the Lake Callide Family Classic are Barramundi, Yellowbelly, Sleepy Cod, and Eel Tailed Catfish and must be of legal length. ALL other fish must be released as soon as possible with minimum harm.
- Legal lengths and bag limits for these fish are Barramundi 58-120cm, Bag Limit 5 with 1 of these 5 being able to be over 120cm, Yellowbelly minimum 30cm, Bag Limit 10, Sleepy Cod no size limit, Bag Limit 20, Eel Tailed Catfish minimum 35cm, Bag Limit 5.
- BAG LIMITS. A maximum of 12 fish per individual may be weighed in and no more than three (3) fish of any one species.
- Each dead fish submitted will have a section of its tail cut to identify that it has already been weighed in.
- Tethering of fish prior to or during the competition will lead to disqualification. The matter can also be handed over to the Queensland Police for investigation and possible prosecution. Nomination fee will not be reimbursed.
- Only one (1) nomination entry per person is permitted.
- Camping permitted in allocated areas ONLY on Friday and Saturday nights
- Competition hours 4am Saturday to 11am Sunday.
- The measuring station will open from 6 am both days and people must be in line with their fish by 11:30 am or 6pm Saturday and 11am Sunday to be eligible.
- Any disputes will be resolved by the Measuring Master and the CVNFSA inc. Executive and their decision is final.
